



In 2021, families of children with disabilities struggled with missed special education services, delayed diagnostic evaluations, disability stigma, community isolation and more. In response, VELA showed up bigger and better by expanding our geographic reach and services!



# of Graduates from our 4 Courses	150	256	70% increase in overall graduates as a result of virtual programming access
# of Case Management Sessions	134	258	92% increase as a result of increased special education supports
# of families in Support Groups	173	250	33% increase of families joining Monthly Support Groups
# of Referrals from our Website	179	351	96% increase of referrals from healthcare providers

We were busy! We also served 967 families through our Drive thru Family Fun Days and 293 families through workshops with school districts.

2021 OUTCOMES

VELA is values-driven and data-informed. All families that participate in VELA's courses complete standardized pre and post tests to measure change. In 2021, after just 5 sessions of our virtual courses, hundreds of families reported significant improvements in advocating for services, building community and accessing emotional support, knowing their rights and connecting to resources.

I know my rights related to my child's disabilities.


